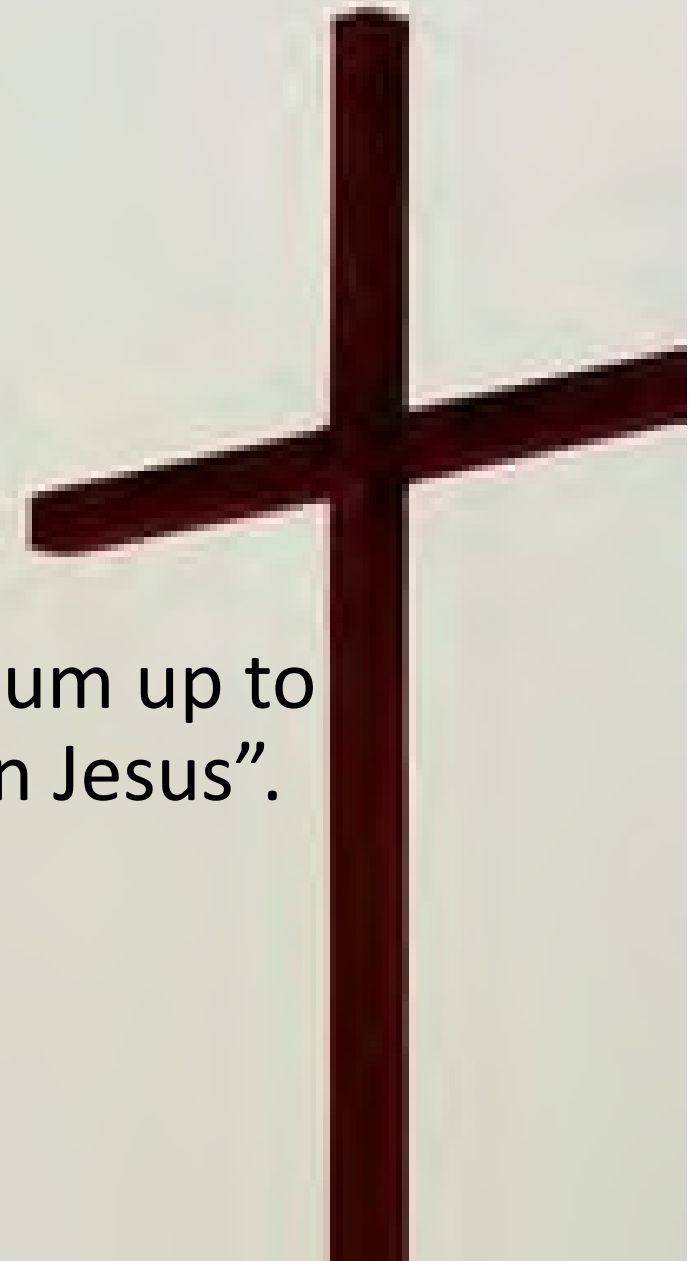

- Over; covering, above and standing on the behalf

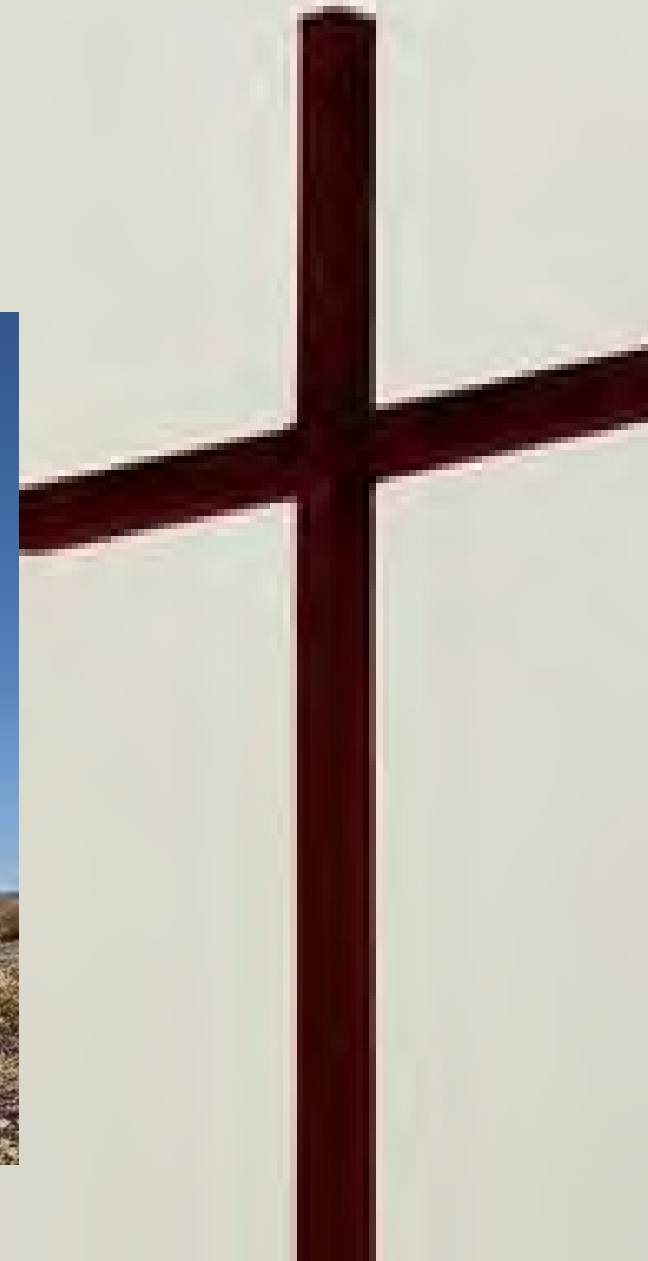

A. Who shall separate us from the love of Christ?

Who?	Greek Definition (Literally)
Tribulation	Pressure at every side
Distress	Limitation to survive
Persecution	Being pursued after
Famine	Scarcity of food
Nakedness	Stripped to punish
Danger	Uncertain danger ahead
Sword	War or Judicial Punishment

B. What does verse 36 mean?

³⁶ As it is written, (Psalm 44:22)
"For Your sake we are being
killed all the day long;
we are regarded as sheep to
be **slaughtered**."



3) Know that God's love is inseparable from us!

c. What is our response...?

³⁷ No, in all these things

we are **More than Conquerors**

through Him who loved us.

More than Conquerors – *hupernikaō* -

Huper: Over and Above literally

Nikao: Conquered, Overcame, Victorious

→ Completely Victorious!

D. God's inseparable love for us

³⁸ ... neither death nor life, (Physical)

nor angels nor rulers, (Spiritual)

nor things present nor things to come, (Time frame)

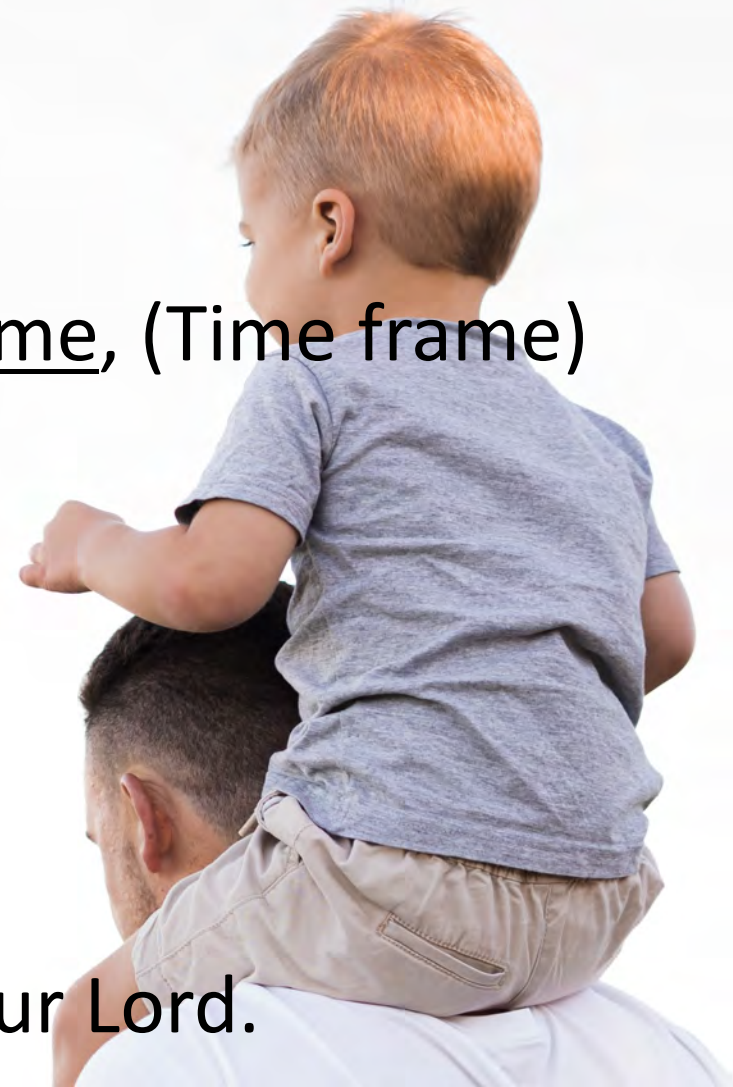
nor powers, ³⁹ (Authority)

nor height nor depth, (Spatial)

nor anything else in all creation,

will be able to separate us from

the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord.
