⁷ It is for discipline that you endure; God deals with you as with sons; for what son is there whom his father does not discipline? ⁸ But if you are without discipline, of which all have become partakers, then you are illegitimate children and not sons. ⁹ Furthermore, we had earthly fathers to discipline us, and we respected them; shall we not much rather be subject to the Father of spirits, and live? ¹⁰ For they disciplined us for a short time as seemed best to them, but He disciplines us for our good, so that we may share His holiness. ¹¹ All discipline for the moment seems not to be joyful, but sorrowful; yet to those who have been trained by it, afterwards it yields the peaceful fruit of righteousness.

How can we strengthen ourselves?

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Why do "bad things" happen to good people?

- i. Refines our character
- ii. Reality of life: not always fine/fair
- iii. Rely on God: we are not in control
- iv. Reconcile others to the fact that God is always good
- v. Bring others relief
- vi. Realise the will of God
- vii. Recognise that we are blessed even in times of discipline/trial

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1 Pet 6 In this you greatly rejoice, even though now for a little while, if necessary, you have been distressed by various trials (discipline), 7 so that the proof of your faith (embraced discipline), being more precious than gold which is perishable, even though tested by fire, may be found to result in praise and glory and honor at the revelation of Jesus Christ;

Therefore, strengthen the hands that are weak and the knees that are feeble, and make straight paths for your feet, so that the limb which is lame may not be put out of joint, but rather be healed.

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- 1. The outcome of *strengthening* and *straightening* will help us to be healed.
- 2. It requires us to rely on God.
- 3. Do not allow the past to affect us further or hurt us i.e. be put out of joint


