But now, Lord, what do I look for?

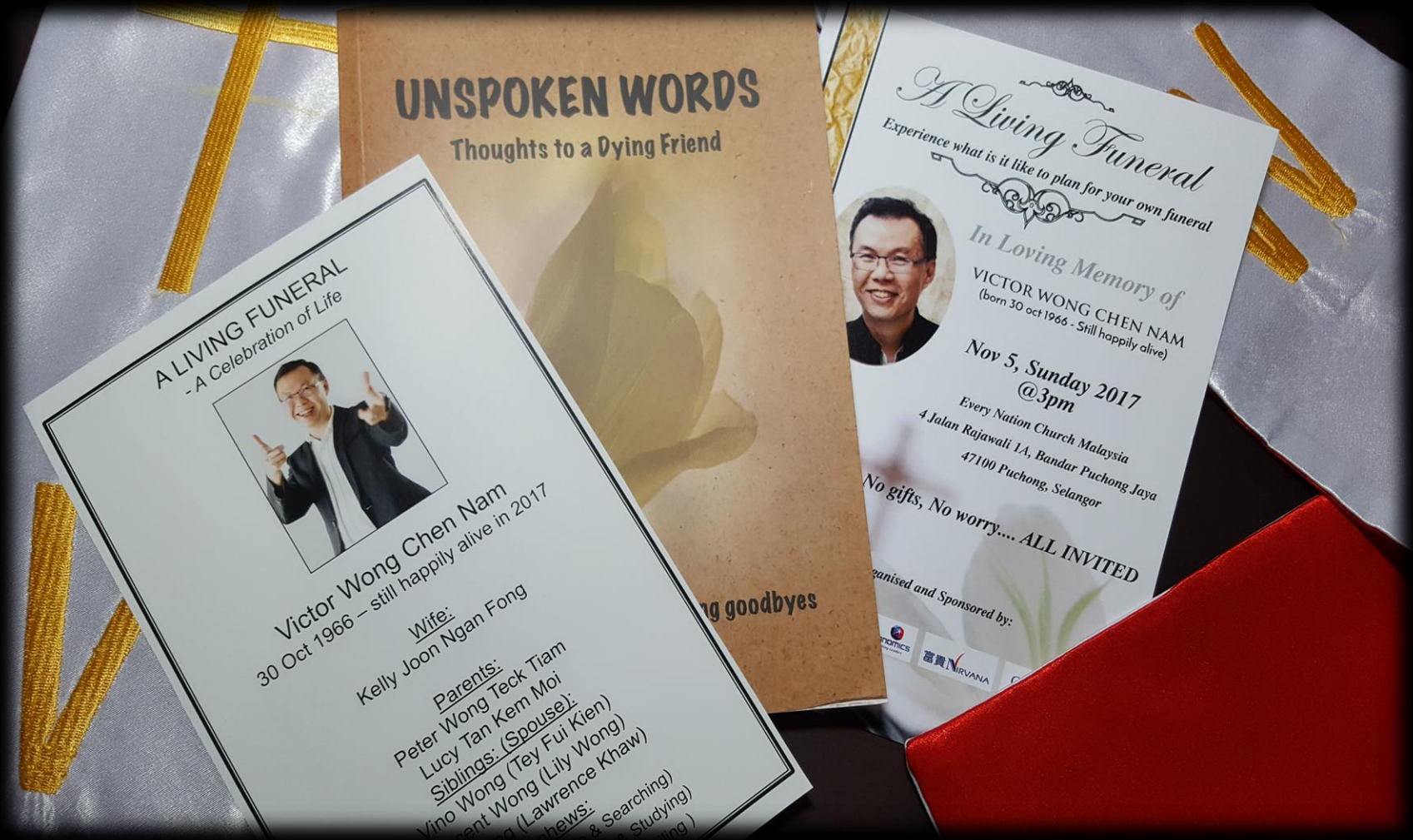

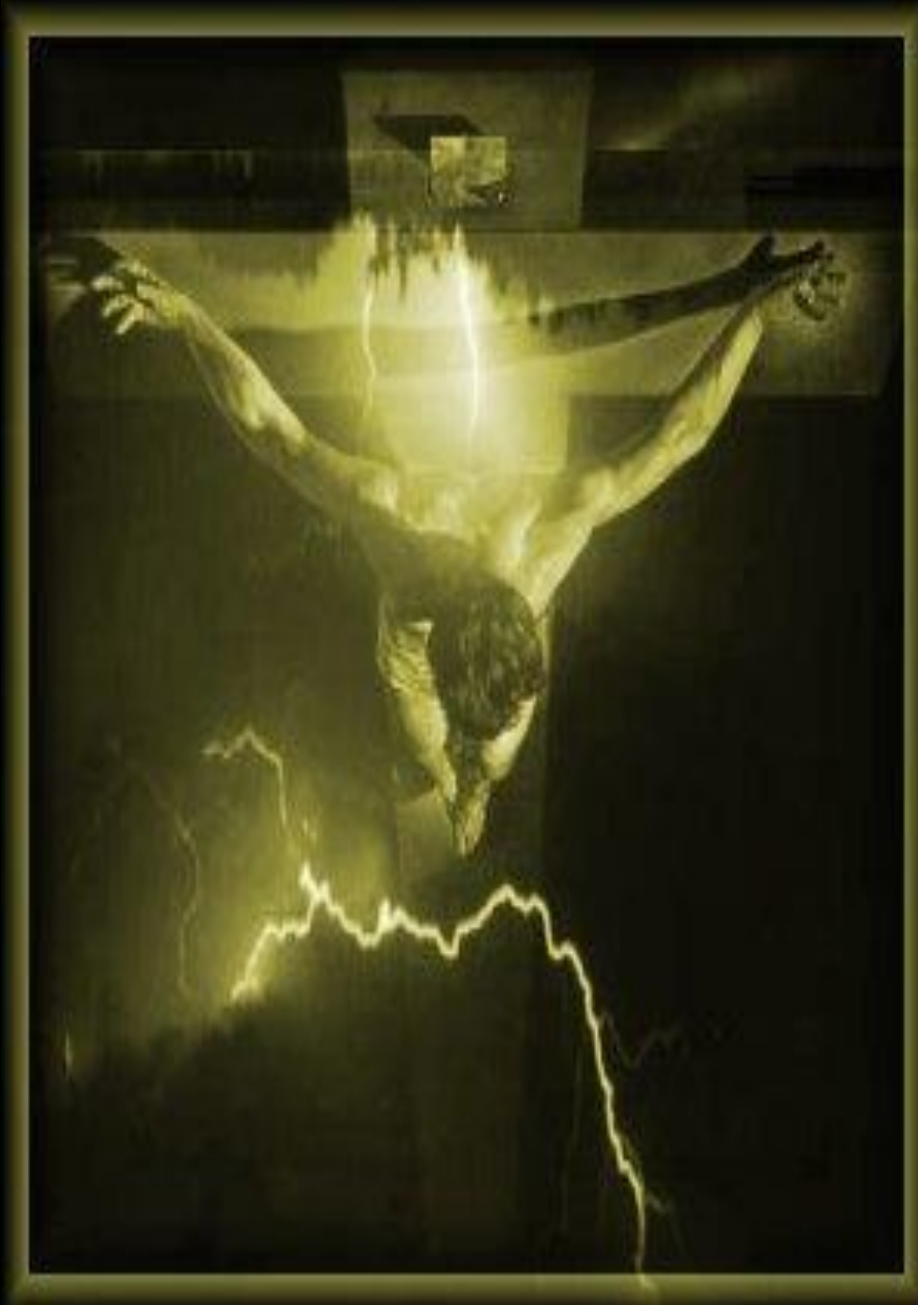
Soul Check
