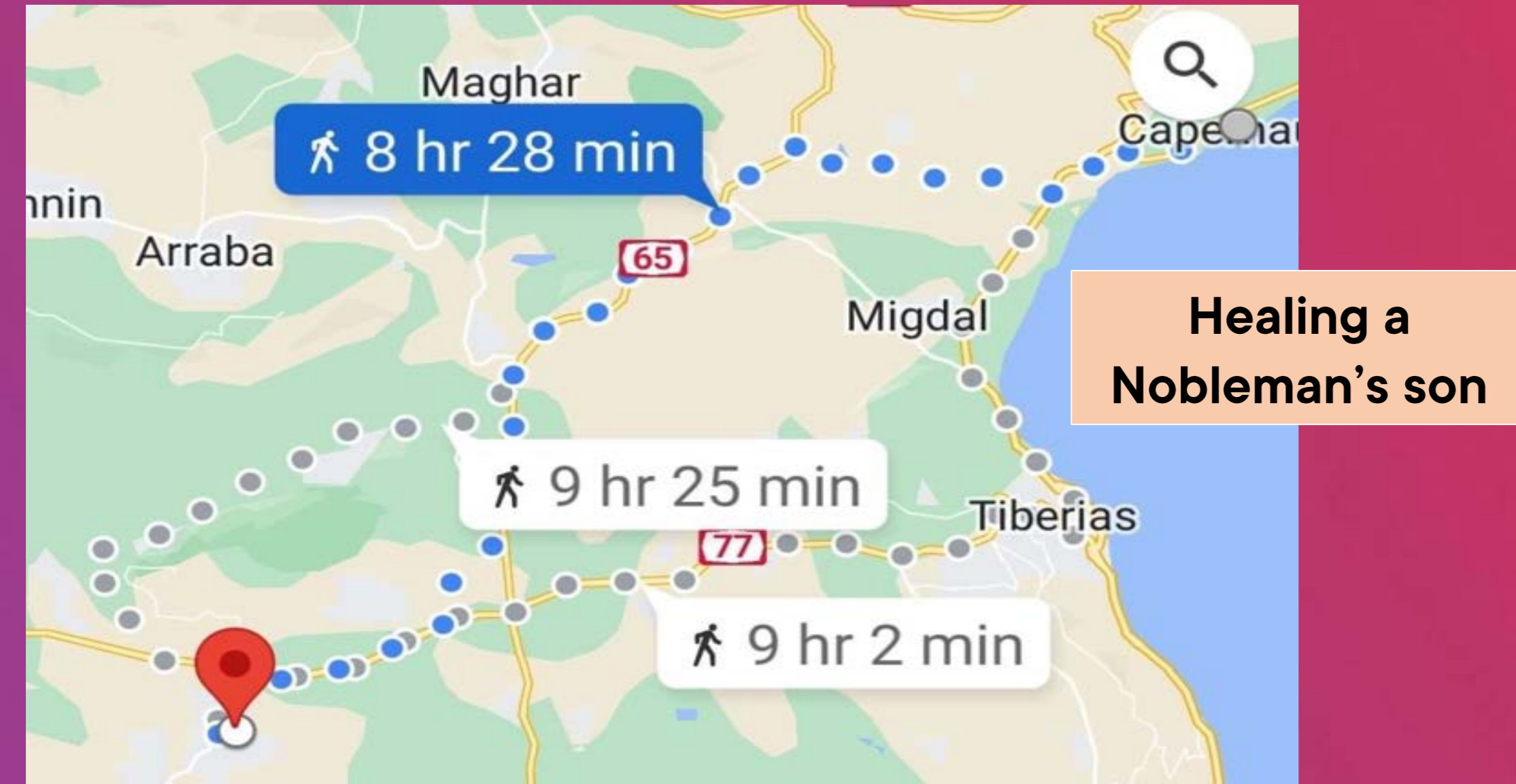

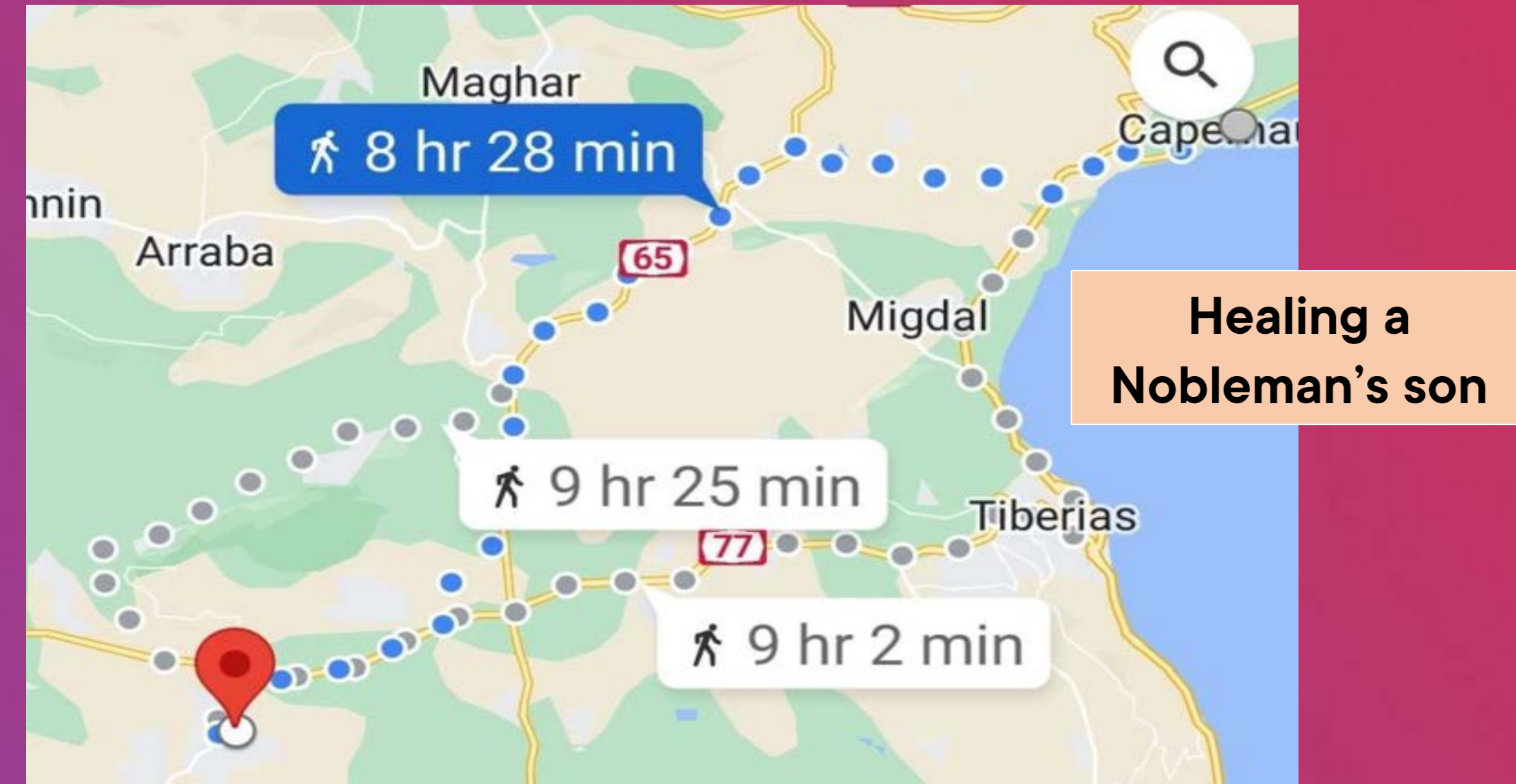

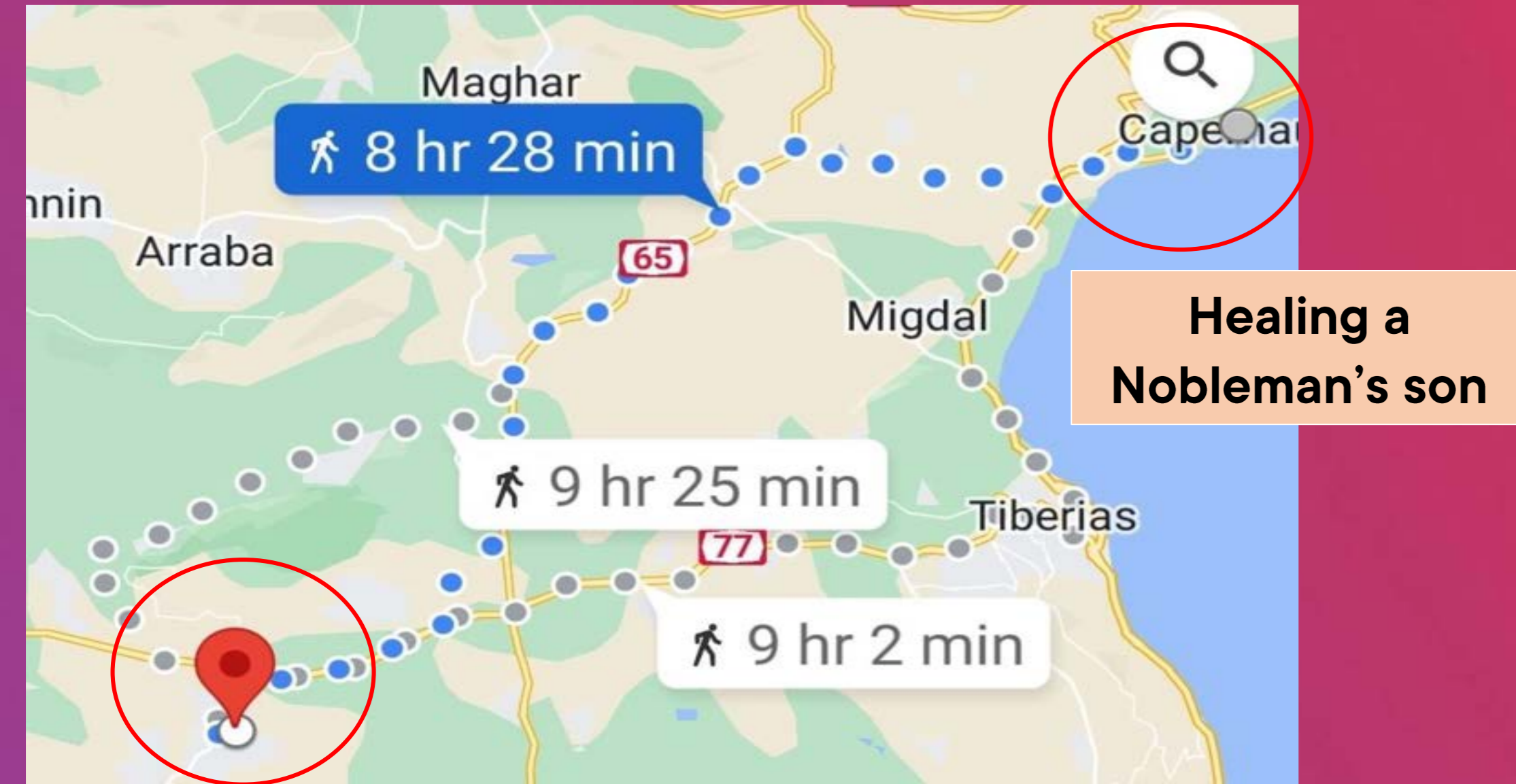
CONTEXT (John 4):

Now when He was in Jerusalem at the Passover during the feast, many believed in His name, **observing His signs which He was doing.**



Healing a Nobleman's son

CONTEXT (John 4):

⁴⁶ Therefore He came again to Cana of Galilee where He had made the water wine. And there was a royal official whose son was sick at Capernaum.

John 4:47

⁴⁷When he heard that Jesus had come out of Judea into Galilee, he went to Him and was imploring Him to come down and heal his son; for he was at the point of death.



The nobleman believed that Jesus could heal his son,
BUT only through physical touch.

His faith lacked two things:

- He limited God's power over distance & death



If we set limits on what Jesus can do, our faith is no greater than the nobleman's.

- How is your faith today?
- Are you limiting the power of God in your life?

Just a word (God’s word) – ***that is all he had and he believed it.***

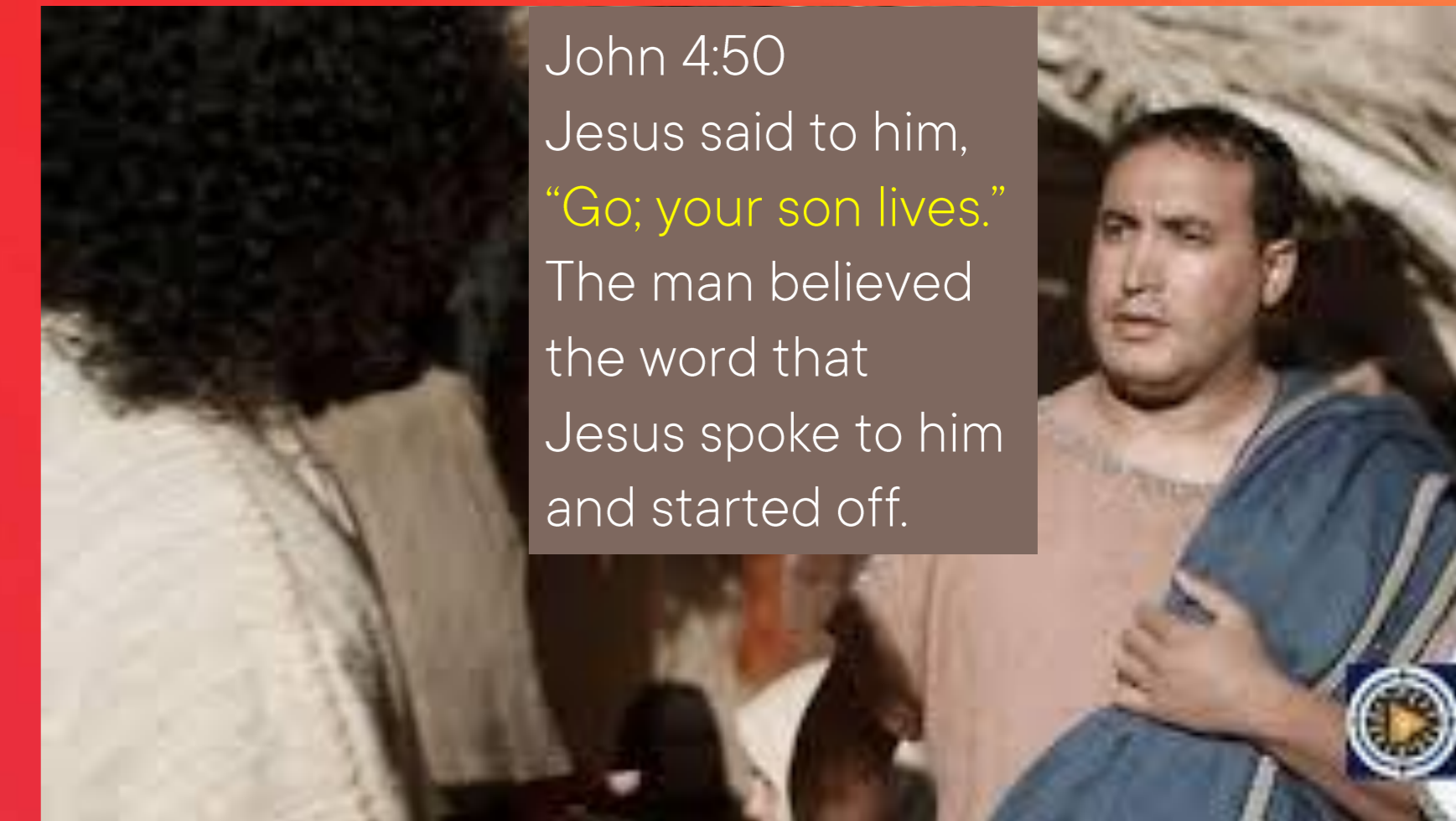


John 2:7
