1 Corinthians 3:10-15

13 each one's work will become clear; for the Day will declare it, because it will be revealed by fire; and the fire will test each one's work, of what sort it is.
14 If anyone's work which he has built on it endures, he will receive a reward.

15 If anyone's work is burned, he will suffer loss; but he himself will be saved, yet so as through fire.

1 Corinthians 3:10-15: our living depicted as:


- o gold, silver, precious stones or wood, hay, straw








Philippians 1:21 For to me, to live is Christ, and to die is gain.










4. Possessions: Stewardship of money, time and resources

- Be spiritually rich






- This has to do with our **commitment** to the things that matter most to us





- Matthew 7:24-25




2 Peter 1:10 Therefore, brethren, be even more diligent to make your call and election sure, for if you do these things you will never stumble.
